- Curriculum Vitae (CV) in English, including a recent photo of the applicant
- Copy of passport or other proof of identification (not required from Icelandic applicants)
- Certificates on previous higher education (the degree certificate and a transcript of records)
- Certificate of English language test taken
- At least two letters of references regarding relevant work/research experience and proven interest in Renewable Energy or the field of science you are applying in the program
- Reference(s) from an academic teacher/supervisor/employer

Any additional information in support of your application is welcome but not requested (e.g. information on work experience). If you are an employee and envisage to re-orientate your career into renewable energy, a covering letter outlining your motivations to participate in the course would be very useful.
